HEALTH AND FITNESS







AURORA BOREALIS

The aurora borealis or northern lights are glowing lights that occur at high northern latitudes. Most times, people will see greenish colour. However, other colours, such as red, white, pink, and blue, are also visible. Aurora is sometimes referred to as 'polar light'. It is predominantly seen in the regions of high altitudes like the Arctic and Antarctic. They generally occur in a band known as 'auroral zone'. The auroral zone is 3 to 6 degree wide in latitude. It lies between 10 and 20 degree from the geomagnetic poles.



Best time to visit Aurora Borealis

The best time to visit aurora borealis is in winter because of the long dark hours throughout the day. The best time to see aurora borealis is at night. This is because sun is brighter than aurora lights. The best month to see aurora lights is between late August and March.

Best location

Rural area Scandinavian countries are of the best place for aurora. One of the best place to see aurora lights is Lapland in Finland, which is the most popular choice of aurora visitors. Because this area is inside the 'aurora band zone' where most of the aurora activity is concentrated.

What makes aurora happen?

When the electrons reach Earth's thin upper atmosphere, they collide with nitrogen and oxygen molecules, sending them into an excited state. The excited electrons eventually calm down and release light, which is what we see as the aurora.

Q. What according to you is special in NEP 2020?

- It is the first Education policy of 21st century.

The National Education Policy (NEP) aims to transform India's education system by 2030. It is a comprehensive framework for elementary education to higher education as well as vocational training in both rural and urban India. The policy aims to reduce the curriculum load of the students and allow them to be more "inter-disciplinary" and "multi-lingual". One example given is "If a student wants to pursue fashion studies with physics, or if one wants to learn bakery with chemistry, they'll be allowed to do so". Report cards will be "holistic", offering information about the student's skills.

The policy of introducing multi-disciplinary institutes will lead to a renewed focus on every field such as arts, humanities and this form of education will help students to learn and grow holistically . 


NEP 2020 aims at making the education system holistic, flexible, multidisciplinary and also to meet the needs and demands of 21st century.

The need for the policy was first felt in 1964 and by the suggestion of Kothari Commission first education policy was passed in 1968. The second policy for education was revised in 1992. After 34 years, the third National Education Policy was released in 29/07/2020. The NEP 2020 is based on the foundation pillars such as access, affordability, equity, quality, and accountability. NEP recommends reconstructing of the entire education domain of India. It talks about foundational and numeracy and skill education to transform India to face 21st century challenges.
