 - Focus on **facts + interpretations**

4. Write the Introduction

- Brief background of the topic
 - Explain why the topic is important
 - Keep it concise (1–2 pages)

5. Develop the Main Content

Divide into headings/subheadings:

- Historical background
- Key features / developments
- Important sites / personalities
- Sources (archaeological/literary)
- Analysis (your understanding)

 Include:

- Maps
 - Diagrams
 - Pictures (with captions)

6. Add Case Study / Source-Based Analysis

- Include extracts (like inscriptions, texts, reports)
 - Interpret them in your own words
 - This is **very important for CBSE evaluation**

7. Conclusion

- Summarize key findings
- Reflect what you learned
- Keep it meaningful, not repetitive

8. Bibliography

List all sources used:

- NCERT book
- Other books
- Websites

Format example:

- NCERT, Themes in Indian History Part I
- www.xyz.com

9. Acknowledgement

- Thank teacher, school, parents, or sources

10. Formatting & Presentation

- Handwritten (usually preferred)
- Neat and well-organized
- Use headings, underline important points
- Add a cover page:
 - Name, class, section, topic, session

3. Certificate (if required)
4. Index
5. Introduction
6. Content
7. Case Study / Sources
8. Conclusion

9. Bibliography
