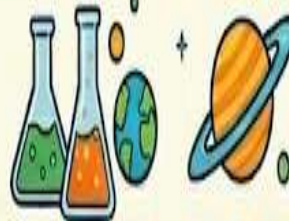
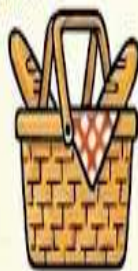

1. आलस्यं हि मनुष्याणां शरीरस्थो महान् रिपुः।
नास्त्यद्यमसमो बन्धुः कृत्वा यं नावसीदति॥

अर्थ: -आलस्य मनुष्य के शरीर में रहने वाला सबसे बड़ा शत्रु है।
उद्योग (मेहनत) के समान कोई मित्र नहीं है, क्योंकि मेहनत करने वाला कभी दुखी नहीं होता।

2. अष्टादश पुराणेषु व्यासस्य वचनं द्वयम्।
परोपकारः पुण्याय पापाय परपीडनम्॥

अर्थ: -अठारह पुराणों में महर्षि व्यास जी ने दो बातें कही हैं—
दूसरों की सहायता करना पुण्य है और दूसरों को कष्ट देना पाप है।

3. प्रियवाक्यप्रदानेन सर्वे तुष्यन्ति जन्तवः।
तस्मात् तदेव वक्तव्यं वचने का दरिद्रता॥

अर्थ: - मीठे वचन बोलने से सभी प्राणी प्रसन्न होते हैं।
इसलिए हमेशा अच्छे शब्द ही बोलने चाहिए, क्योंकि बोलने में कोई कमी (गरीबी) नहीं होती।

4. षड्दोषाः पुरुषेणैह हन्तव्याः भूतिमिच्छता।
निद्रा तन्द्रा भयं क्रोधः आलस्यं दीर्घसूत्रता॥

अर्थ: - जो व्यक्ति उन्नति चाहता है, उसे इन छह दोषों को छोड़ देना चाहिए—
अधिक सोना, आलस्य, डर, क्रोध, सुस्ती और काम को टालना।

5. वस्त्रेण वपुषा वाचा विद्यया विनयेन च।
वकारैः पञ्चभिर्युक्तः नरः भवति पूज्यते॥

अर्थ: - अच्छे वस्त्र, सुंदर शरीर, मधुर वाणी, विद्या और विनयता—
इन पाँच गुणों से युक्त व्यक्ति सम्मान के योग्य होता है।

मन्दम् = धीरे

पिबति = पीता है

वाक्य:

1 छात्रः लिखति। 2 अहं जलं पिबामि। 3 सः तिष्ठति।

अर्थः

अहं जलं पिबामि। = मैं जल पीता हूँ।

- Glue, scissors

Steps to Prepare:

- Take a cardboard base and draw a classroom/ parliament layout
- Make small paper figures or cut-outs to show:
 - Speaker (teacher/ leader)
 - Members (students)
- Arrange them like a discussion setup (facing each other)
- Write labels like “Speaker” and “Members”
- Add 2–3 rules on small slips (example: Keep class clean, Save water)
- Decorate your model neatly

Final Step:

Write 4–5 lines explaining:

- What does your model show?
- How are rules made?
- Why are rules important?
