INSTRUCTIONS:

- Reporting Time:** Students must report to the school by **7:40 a.m. sharp**. Late arrival will not be permitted.
- Dispersal Time:** (The departure time will be at 11:45 am irrespective of the exam duration). **October 3, 2026** will be a regular working day for all the classes.
- Duration of Examination:** The examination duration will be **three hours**, except for Computers and Sanskrit, which will be of 1 hour 30 minutes and carry 50 marks each.
- School Uniform & ID Card:** Students **must report in the regular school uniform and carry their valid School ID Card. Smart Watches and Electronic Gadgets are strictly not allowed.** Entry to the examination will be subject to compliance with these requirements.
- Permitted Items:** Students **must carry a transparent water bottle and their stationery in a transparent pouch.** No unnecessary items will be permitted.

6. **Examination Syllabus:** The **Half-Yearly Examination syllabus** is available on the school website. Students and parents **must refer to the prescribed syllabus and ensure adequate preparation.**
7. **Reporting to Examination Room:** Students must **proceed directly to their respective classrooms as per the seating arrangement displayed/communicated by the school.** They are required to maintain discipline and follow all instructions issued by the examination authorities.
8. **Re-examination will not be conducted.** Students are therefore required to appear for the examination on the scheduled date and time.
